THE LOST RING

My husband, Max, and I have been married for more than thirty-five years. When we got engaged, Max gave me a beautiful diamond ring. I loved the ring and wore it everywhere I went.

5 The summer after we got married, Max and I went on vacation. We stayed at a lovely hotel right next to a small lake. We enjoyed watching the swans and ducks in the lake. We also watched the boaters rowing around. It looked like so much fun that one day, we decided to join them.

10 We rented a small rowboat and spent a wonderful afternoon on the lake. When we got off the boat, however, I suddenly noticed that my diamond ring was missing! We immediately started searching the boat, but couldn't find it anywhere. I realized that it must have fallen in the water. I was very upset because I knew that there was no way that we could find the ring in the lake.

15 Last summer, Max and I decided to go on vacation to the same hotel we had gone to so many years before. We went rowing again, but this time, I took off all my rings first. While we were there, I told the owner of the hotel the story of my missing ring. He became very excited and asked me to describe the ring. "You won't believe this," he said, "but we found your ring!"

20 He explained: "Three years ago, one of my sons went fishing in the lake and caught a big fish. He asked the hotel chef to cook it for his dinner. When the chef opened up the fish, he found a diamond ring. We were all very surprised. My wife remembered that a guest had once lost a ring in the lake, but she couldn't remember who it was. We decided to keep the ring and see if its owner ever came back to our hotel."

He went to his office and came back with a very familiar diamond ring. I was very extremely surprised - and so happy. After so many years, I finally had my lost ring back.
